If you are a Ministry Partner, there is a list in the church foyer for you to write down if you are able to contribute to the meal. **Sheila Hooper. 0414 790 691**


EBC Maintenance Day: Saturday 13th April:

Men die by suicide at much higher rates than women across all age groups. Among older men, loss of purpose and identity after retirement, weaker connections to children and grandchildren and to social networks can all be factors. Peninsula Men's Shed are seeking to help men in this vulnerable stage of life. Graham, our men's shed chaplain, and Bruce our men's shed President featured in the Guardian newspaper this week talking about the dangers of Male Suicide and how the Peninsula Men's shed is addressing this.
