## From Pastor David: A Compelling Message:

Do you ever have bad days? Paul did. He describes some of them in his second letter the Corinthians, "Three times I was beaten with rods, once I was pelted with stones, three times I was shipwrecked, I spent a night and a day in the open sea, I have been constantly on the move. I have been in danger from rivers, in danger from bandits, in danger from my fellow Jews, in danger from Gentiles; in danger in the city, in danger in the country, in danger at sea; and in danger from false believers." (2 Corinthians 11:25–26 NIV)

But Paul wasn't complaining. He was compelled to face all that because of Christ's love for us. Paul stated, "Christ's love compels us."

At Easter we remember Christ loved us so much he was willing to die for us. But we also remember he is alive! Easter is a celebration of His resurrection: God brought Jesus back from the dead, proving he's broken the power of sin and death. He died to give us life!

Easter is not some memorial to a nice, good religious teacher who lived 2,000 years ago. It's a celebration of the fact that He is alive today. I'm living proof—and so are approximately 1 billion Christians who celebrate Easter. Jesus "was shown to be the Son of God when He was raised from the dead by the power of the Holy Spirit. He is Jesus Christ our Lord" (Romans 1:4).

And that's truly compelling.

## This Sunday @ 9.30am: A Love that changes the world.:


