From The Pastor: Live By Faith

I love stories, and this Sunday in our 9.30am service we are considering a story that Jesus told that is not so well known. It's from Luke 16:1-15, the story about a dishonest, yet shrewd manager. Before being dismissed from his job, this manager wisely gave away some of his boss' money.

Through this story Jesus teaches that our use of money is a good test of how committed we are to Christ. We are reminded that (1) Money belongs to God, not us; let us use our resources wisely. (2) Money can be used for good or evil; let us use ours for good. (3) Money has a lot of power, let us use it carefully and thoughtfully. We must use our material goods in a way that will foster faith and obedience.

On Sunday, I will show you four Biblical principles of money management found in this passage. These principles apply to you whether you have a job, whether you've lost a job, whether you've got lots of money, or whether you've got no money. They are universal principles that come from this parable that help us to get some insight as to what we should do also during this time when money is so tight and there are many struggling with financial hardship.

As always, the Bible is as relevant today as it has always been.
