From Pastor David... In the Footsteps of Paul:

Over the next two Sundays in our 9.30am service we will continue to be introduced to Paul. This week we will be reading Acts 13:1-13 and considering the Mission of Paul. Next Sunday we will be reading Acts 13:13-52 and considering the Message of Paul.

The last thing Jesus said to his disciples before ascending to his Father was: 'you will receive power when the Holy Spirit comes on you; and you will be my witnesses in Jerusalem, and in all Judea and Samaria, and to the ends of the earth. ' (Acts 1:8) Acts is the story of how that happens.

The gospel goes out, carried by messengers, empowered by the Holy Spirit. It's sent under God's control to Jews (Acts 1-7), Samaritans (Acts 8-11) and Gentiles (Acts 12-28). They carry the glorious news: 'God has made this Jesus, whom you crucified, both Lord and Messiah', and so 'Salvation is found in no one else, for there is no other name under heaven given to mankind by which we must be saved' (Acts 2:36, 4:12).

The journey was not always easy, but Paul faithfully proclaimed the gospel wherever he went because he knew God is in control, he loves people and he changes people, just as he changed Paul. That news rings out to the ends of the earth. It's even come to the Central Coast, of all places. The big message of Acts is that the gospel is unstoppable! God will save through the message of Jesus, and God's Church will grow. Are you part of that church? Are you part of that mission? Blessings, David Gilchrist
