## From Pastor David...In the Footsteps of Paul:

In 4 weeks', time 15 friends, mainly from our church at Ettalong, with a few other people we know, will be travelling on a tour "in the footsteps of Paul." We will be travelling to Rome, Turkey, and Greece and visiting many of the same places Paul visited.

Over the next 3 Sundays in our 9.30am service we will be reflecting on Paul and his passion for Jesus Christ. We are starting this Sunday by asking, who was Paul?

Almost 2000 years ago, Paul, under arrest and facing a screaming mob, stood on the Garrison steps in Jerusalem to speak in his own defence. He began with these words. "I am a Jew., born in Tarsus in Cilicia, but brought up here in Jerusalem as a student of Gamaliel. I received strict instruction in the law of our ancestors." (Acts 22).

Paul's world, The world of the 1st century. AD., dominated by the power of Rome, ~ Greek culture, pagan, superstitious ~ and our world have much in common. Certainly, both share the same deep need for the good news Paul brought of new life made possible through Jesus Christ, for hope to lift men and women from despair. As Paul brought his message to Jews and non-Jews, to Athens and Corinth and even Rome itself, some made an instant response. Others were violent in their opposition of Paul and his message. Who then was this man? A Jew of Jews with a mission also to non-Jews. A free born Roman citizen. God's man for his time.
