Roadworks on Maitland Bay Drive:

Roadworks on Maitland Bay Drive and Memorial Avenue, and the Gravel Car Park behind the Church:

The roundabout next to the church, which connects Maitland Bay Dr, Memorial Ave and Barrenjoey Rd, and its approaches, is to be widened, with a slip lane added closer to the mountain, and a shared pedestrian path track added on the church side, alongside the gravel car park used by the church.

This will cause some minor disruptions and temporary restrictions to some parking spaces in the gravel car park during utility relocation. The church will be kept informed of these works and fenced off areas during construction. The work is planned to take place from early July until approximately the first half of 2025, weather permitting.
