From the Pastor:

Max Lucado writes, "If anyone had a reason to be anxious it was the apostle, Paul! Envision an old man as he gazes out the window of a Roman prison; half-blind, squinting just to read; awaiting trial before the Roman emperor. His future is as gloomy as his gaol cell."

This Sunday we continue our series from the life of Paul, "The Challenge of a Changed Man," looking at his attitude in his letter to the Philippians. He wrote to the Philippians from his prison cell. But as he sits, chained, he never once dwells on his troubles. Instead, he chooses to focus on Christ and praises him, for he is in control. He challenges the Philippians, and he challenges you and me to do the same.

Read Paul's words in Philippians 4. You'd think he'd just arrived at a beach resort. His letter to the Philippians bears not a word of fear or complaint. Not one! Instead, he lifts his thanks to God. He challenges us to do the same "Rejoice in the Lord always. Again, I say, rejoice!" (Philippians 4:4).

Are you in prison? Do you feel trapped? Maybe you're having to move, and you don't want to leave your home or all that is dear to you. Maybe your hopes and dreams have been crushed and you are left feeling helpless. Maybe you need work, and no one will give you a go. Maybe you're in hospital and you don't feel like you're getting any better. Maybe you literally are in prison, wasting your life away. Paul's challenge to us is a decision deeply rooted in the confidence that God exists, that he is in control, and that he is good. We can trust in him. Rejoice in the Lord—always! You can't run the world, but you can entrust it to God!

Annual Church Meeting - Sunday 25th August, 11am to 1pm:

We believe that every true member of God's church is a Priest. Four times we meet to make decisions about the business of the church here at Ettalong. One of these meetings, every August, is our annual meeting when we affirm people to lead our church.

This year we need to affirm:

• A Church Secretary.

The church secretary is a Church Deacon (church leader) who keeps minutes of meetings, looks after correspondence and liaises with our office manager to correctly file and keep meeting records.

• A Property Officer.

Geoff Toon is retiring from this role. The property officer can be a Deacon or can be represented by one of the Deacons. We have many people who can help with the day-to-day maintenance of our church property, but the property officer manages them and makes sure our buildings and property are maintained.

• A Deacon with no portfolio.

It would be wonderful to have another Deacon who can help us practically lead the church and help the Pastor, Elders and other Deacons make important decisions for the day-to-day smooth running of the church.

• A Nominations Committee member.

After serving in this role for 6 years Sheila Hooper needs to have a year off from the Nominations Committee. The nominations committee calls for nominations and identifies volunteers to fill various roles in the church, which are affirmed by the church meeting.
