We donate the giftfilled shoeboxes, and they are distributed to children in over 100 countries in the Name of Jesus Christ. After receiving a shoebox gift, many children have the opportunity to enrol in The Greatest Journey – a 12-lesson Bible study course that guides children through what it means to faithfully follow Jesus Christ. The mission of Operation Christmas Child is to provide God's love in a tangible way to children in need around the world, and together with the local church worldwide, to share the Good News of Jesus Christ.

In our 9.30am service we will be praying over the boxes of gifts that we have collected, and praying for those who will receive the boxes, that they will be blessed by the gift, and know the love of Jesus Christ that is sent with the gift.
